Boat on the Nile

The boat trip across the Nile is a wonderful trip while visiting Luxor to enjoy the beautiful nature of the immortal Nile River to the melodies of oriental music.

Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut

Hatshepsut (c.1473–1458 BC), the queen who became pharaoh, built a magnificent temple at Deir al-Bahari, on the west back of Luxor.

Valley of the Kings

known as the Valley of the Gates of the Kings, for a period of nearly 500 years from the 16th to 11th century BC, rock-cut tombs were excavated for the pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom. The valley stands on the west bank of the Nile opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis.

Luxor Temple

is a large Ancient Egyptian temple complex located on the east bank of the Nile River in the city today known as Luxor (ancient Thebes) and was constructed approximately 1400 BC.

The Colossi of Memnon

are two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III, which stand at the front of the ruined Mortuary Temple of Amenhotep III, the largest temple in the Theban Necropolis. They have stood there since 1350 BC and were well known to ancient Greeks and Romans, as well as early modern travelers and Egyptologists.
